The Wolverine Golf Schools offer outstanding instructional opportunities for golfers of all ages and abilities who are interested in improving their games at the University of Michigan.

The coaches of the “2009 NCAA FINAL FOUR” Michigan men’s golf team will teach fundamentals for the short game, give personal full-swing instruction, and address on-course strategies. Students will participate in skill contests and on-course playing assignments. Coaches will lead discussions on practice techniques and long-term game development, as well as college recruitment for junior players.

The final day of each session includes a school tournament at the University of Michigan Golf Course.

Every student graduates from the Wolverine Golf School with online videos of his swing for future reference, a personalized report with a coach's evaluation, and a game plan for continued improvement.

June 28-July 1

Junior golfers grades 6-12 will work to develop good fundamentals, practice habits, and course strategies. Campers will receive individual instruction from varsity coaches, complete two nine-hole playing assignments, perform practice drills, learn about junior tournament schedules and college recruiting, and participate in an 18-hole camp tournament. Each participant graduates with a personalized plan for continued improvement at the end of camp. Camp size is limited to the first 32 participants.

## CAMP DIRECTORS

Head men's golf coach **Andrew Sapp** is in his eighth year at Michigan. Coach Sapp is a former player and coach at the University of North Carolina and also coached at Purdue. In his career, Sapp has coached eight All-Americans and guided his teams to 32 titles. He led the Wolverines to the NCAA Final Four in 2009 at the Inverness Club in Toledo, Ohio.



Assistant men's golf coach **Chris Whitten** is in his fourth year at Michigan. Before coming to Ann Arbor, he was the men's assistant golf coach at his alma mater, the University of Notre Dame. Chris is a PGA Class A Member.

## FACILITY



All schools and camps are held at the home of the Wolverines, the University of Michigan Golf Course. Designed by Alister MacKenzie and opened in 1931, UMGC is consistently rated as one of the best collegiate golf courses in the nation. Students will also utilize the Varsity Short Game Facility.
